The process for medical imaging

The breast surgeon has seen you in the Outpatient Area at Modbury Hospital and referred you to Benson Radiology for medical imaging.

Once your imaging is complete you will return to the Outpatient Area to see the breast surgeon again for your results.

Some review patients may be pre-booked for medical imaging prior to seeing the breast surgeon.

As part of your imaging, a biopsy may also be requested. The breast surgeons and the specialist radiologist work in close collaboration to determine your required imaging.

How the breast clinic works

The Radiology Department allocates resources specifically for Breast Clinic patients.

Your imaging will be performed by our highly trained technical staff and reported by a specialist radiologist.

You may experience slight delays in the Radiology Department if further imaging or biopsy procedures are required.

If there is something we can do to make your wait more comfortable please ask one of our staff. If you have been waiting for more than 45 minutes please approach our reception desk.

At our Modbury Hospital Radiology Department, we offer a full range of imaging services.

As such, you may notice other patients being taken through before you as they are here for other booked imaging examinations.

Please be assured all Breast Clinic patients will be seen in order.

You will not miss out on seeing the breast surgeon on your return to the Outpatient Area.
